

The 'Be ACTIVE' Framework for Active Learning

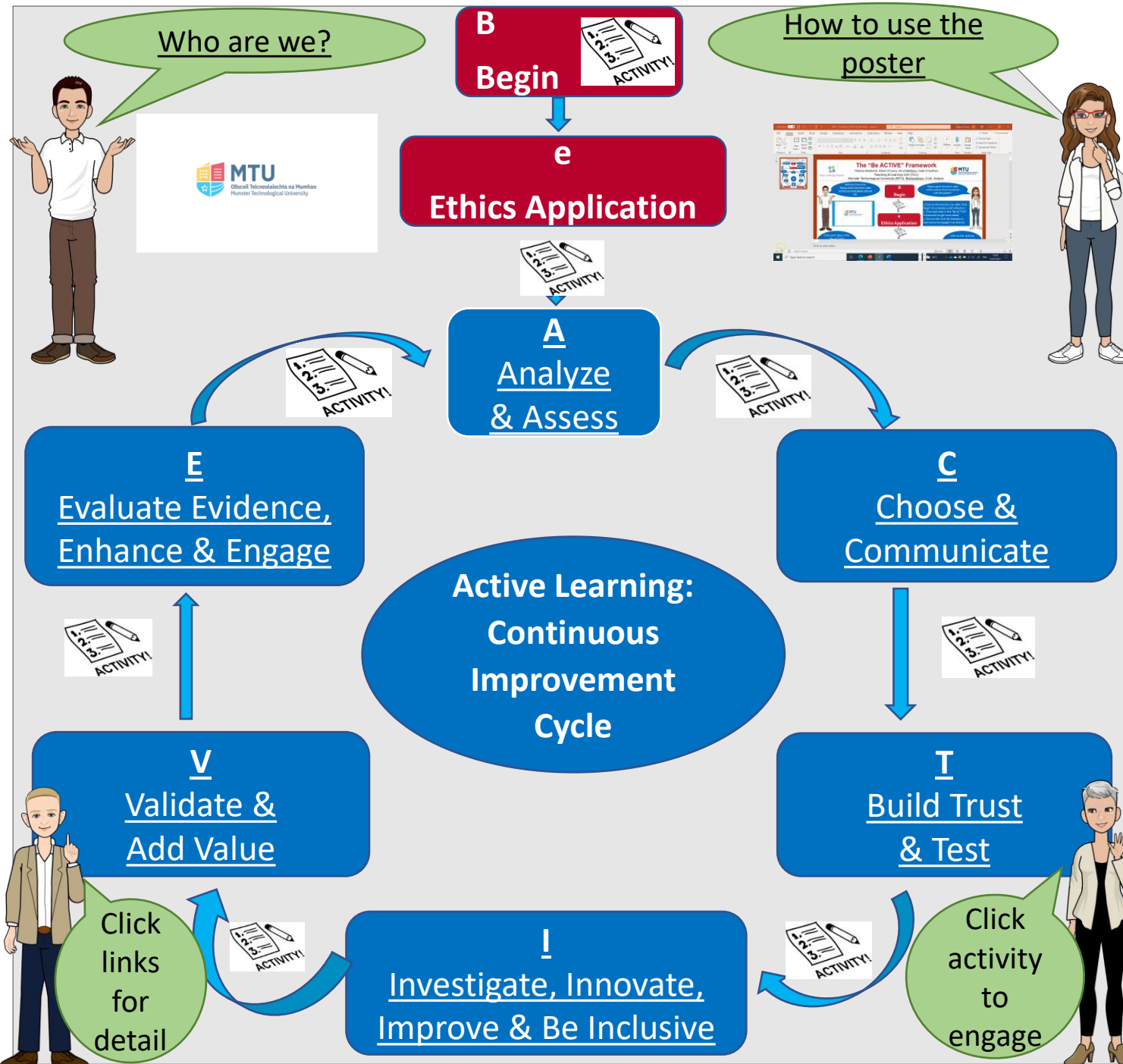
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Aims

An exploratory Framework which aims to

- Support staff and institutions to embed active learning (AL) in their everyday practice in a structured and supported manner.
- Support staff to engage in SoTL using an action research approach and disseminate best practice in relation to active learning.



Findings

Need to manage student expectations: *"Staff need to induct students into learning actively (scaffolding etc)"*

Staff need support and CPD: *"Staff don't know what they don't know....Lack time to invest in doing that"*

Need to share benefits of AL with staff & students

Proposed Impact

1. Active learning (AL) embedded across institutions nationally and internationally
2. Enhanced staff engagement in scholarly activity through a structured framework which supports planning and implementation of AL based action research.
3. Enhanced student engagement & success
